TG EAPCET Counselling Process: Step-by-Step Guide

Telangana State Council of Higher Education will conduct the TS EAMCET counselling process 2025 online at the official website. All the qualified candidates can participate in the counselling process.

TG EAPCET counselling will be conducted in 3 rounds. There will also be one special round for Internal Sliding and the Spot Admission. Candidates need to register and pay the fee to participate in the counselling process.

TG EAPCET Counselling Process 2025

After qualifying for the TG EAPCET entrance exam, candidates need to appear for the counselling process to get the desired college along with the preferred course. You can check the steps below for the TG EAPCET seat allocation process.

How To Apply?

Step 1: Registration and Counselling Fee Payment

The first step of the TG EAPCET counselling process 2025 is registration and fee payment. Check the steps below to know the registration process.

- Visit the TS EAMCET 2025 counselling website, tgeapcet.nic.in.
- Click on the Candidate Registration link and enter your Registration Number received via mobile. Enter your TS EAMCET hall ticket number for 2025, your rank in the entrance exam, and your date of birth.
- Click on “Generate Password.”
- The candidate will see their details on the screen, verify all the information, and create a password for future logins.
- To complete the registration process, click on the “Save Password” button.
- Candidates will see a “Registration Successful” message after completing the registration.

Enter TGEAPCET Hall Ticket No and TGEAPCET Registration No (as printed on TGEAPCET Hall Ticket) and Date of Birth and Image Value and Click the below button, **if you have already paid the fee through Online Payment and found transaction failed.** Use this facility at least 30 minutes after the transaction initiation.
2. The candidate will be directed to payment gateway for verifying the status of previous transactions. Scroll down to view the transaction details.
3. In the event of transaction failure amount will be credited back into your account after two working days.
4. Contact nearest Help Line Centre for any other clarifications.
5. After successful payment of fee, if the candidate is unable to generate Joining Report, after two hours please click on Verify Payment Status on the same day and enter Candidate Details (HT No., Registration No, Date of Birth and Image Value) and click on Verify Payment Transaction then Self-Report and download Joining Report.

Step 2: Verification of Documents

After the registration process and fee payment, the second step includes document verification. Candidates are required to visit the nearest help centres for verification. Check the list below of the **documents required for TG EAPCET counselling 2025.**

Documents Required for TG EAMCET Counselling

- TG EAPCET 2025 hall ticket
- Income certificate (if applicable)
- Caste certificate issued by the competent authority (if applicable)
- Transfer Certificate (T.C)
- SSC or its equivalent mark sheet
- Residence certificate in case the candidate has no institutionalised education
- Intermediate or its equivalent memo-cum-pass certificate
- Residence certificate of either of the parents in Telangana for 10 years in case of Non-Local candidates
- Aadhaar card
- TG EAPCET rank card 2025
- 6th standard to inter-study certificates

- Physically challenged (PH)/Children of Armed Personnel (CAP)/NCC/Sports/Minority certificate if applicable

Documents Required by PH/CAP/NCC/Sports/Minority Candidates

- Minorities - SSC TC containing Minority Status or Certificate from the headmaster
- NCC & Sports - Original Certificates issued by competent authorities
- PH certificate issued by the District Medical Board. Candidates with 40% and above disability are considered eligible
- Anglo-Indian - Certificate issued by the Tahsildar of their place of residence
- CAP certificate issued by Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer - Identity card and Discharge book (in case of Ex-Servicemen) and Service Certificate (in case of in-service men) issued by the Competent Authority for verification.

Step 3: Choice Filling

After the successful document verification, the next step is to fill in your choices of courses and colleges in the order of your preference. The order of the preferences should be from highest to lowest, and there is no limit of choices. Candidates are advised to choose as many options as they want. Check the steps below to fill in your choices.

- Visit the official website of TG EAPCET.
- Click on the Candidate Login link.
- Candidates need to log in with their hall ticket number, registration number, password, and date of birth. Candidates will receive an OTP to their registered mobile number.
- Click on the "Click Here for Option Entry" button by giving the OTP to exercise web options. Select the district where the college is located.
- Next, candidates need to click on the "Display Option Entry Form" button.
- Enter your college choices in order of preference.
- After filling in all choices, candidates must save their options, which will be locked for seat allotment.
- Take a printout of the selected options for future reference.

Step 4: Seat Allotment

After completing the choice-filling step, Candidates must save their options, which will then be locked for the seat allotment. Following this, the seat allotment result will be available online. To check the result, candidates should log into the portal and carefully enter their ROC form number, application number, hall ticket number, and date of birth.

Candidates have the option to accept the allocated seat or opt to participate in the next round of seat allotment. If a candidate decides to accept their seat, they will need to download the provisional seat allotment letter from the official website.

Step 5: Payment of Tuition Fees

After accepting the seat, candidates need to pay the tuition fee, which is mentioned in the provisional seat allotment letter. The payment is made online through debit card/ credit card/ net banking, and confirms your admission.

If the Tuition Fee is Displayed as Zero:

In case the tuition fee is displayed as zero, then the candidates have to self-report by logging in and accepting the allotted seat.

The joining report, along with the admission number, will be generated after clicking on "Accept my Joining". Candidates need to submit the seat allotment letter along with the joining report to the allotted Institutes.

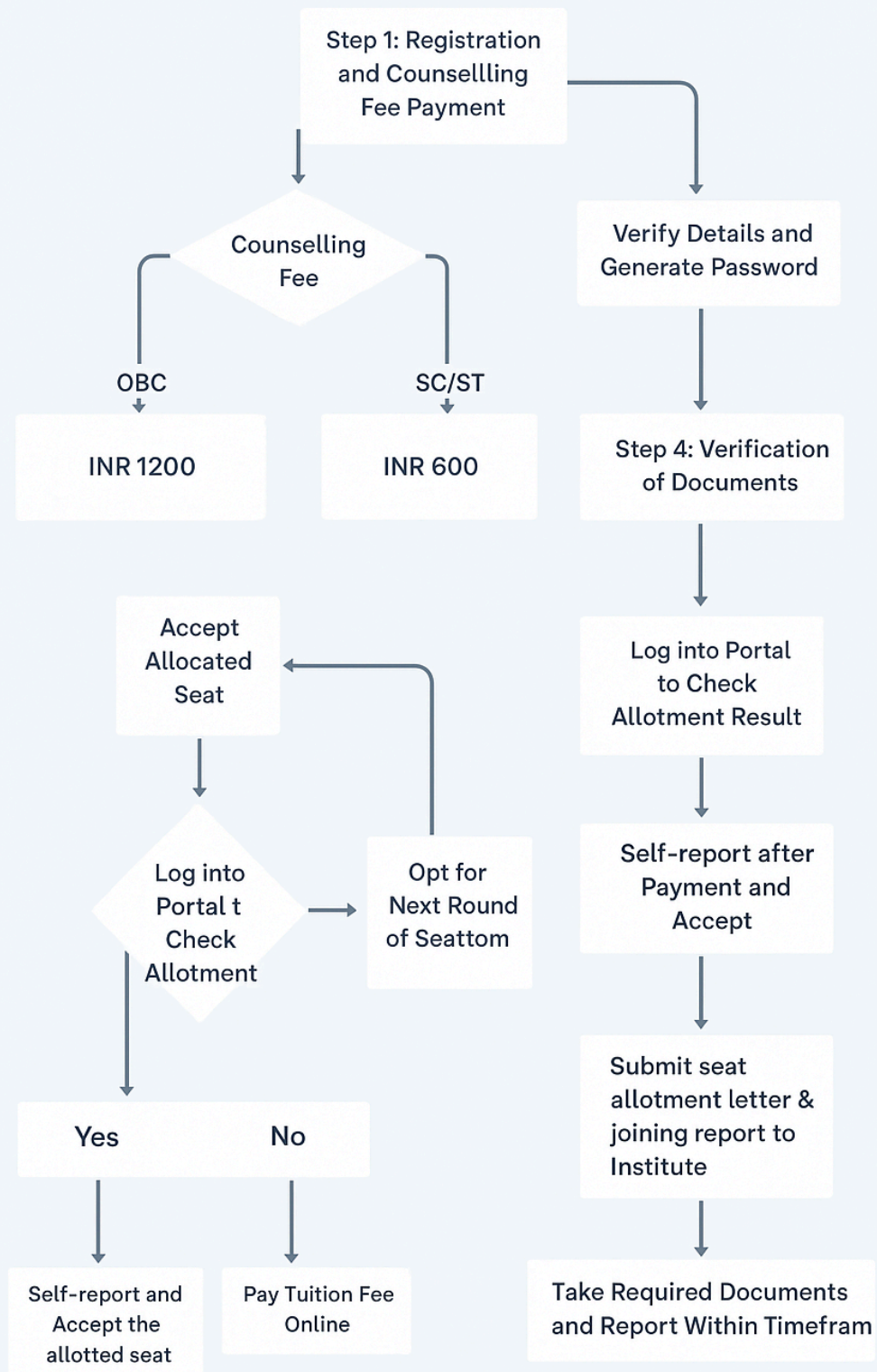
If the Tuition Fee is not displayed as zero:

The candidate needs to pay the tuition fee online in case it is not displayed as zero. Self-report after making the payment and click on “Accept my Joining”. Submit the seat allotment letter along with the joining report to the allotted College.

Step 6: Reporting to the Allotted Institutes

As the last step of the counselling process, candidates need to take all the required documents and report to the allotted Institute within the stipulated time. Failing to do so will cancel the admission of the candidates.

How Can I Download the Seat Allotment Result of TG EAPCET 2025?

The TS EAMCET 2025 seat allotment result will be released online. After successful registration and payment of fees for the counselling process, you need to lock your choices of seat allotment. Candidates can check the steps below to download the TG EAPCET seat allotment result for 2025.

- Visit the official website of TSCHE.
- On the Homepage, click on the login option.
- Next, candidates need to carefully enter the following information:
 - TS EAMCET Hall Ticket Number
 - ROC Number
 - Date of Birth
 - Password

Carefully check all the information.

- Finally, click on the submit button.
- The seat allotment result will be displayed on the screen

If you are satisfied, accept the seat and proceed to download the seat allotment letter.

- Refresh the page and go to the TG EAPCET seat allotment result link.
- Candidates need to enter their login details and submit them to get the seat allotment letter.
- Download the letter and take a printout for future reference.

Important Points To Remember

The TS EAMCET (Telangana State Engineering, Agriculture and Medical Common Entrance Test) counselling process is a crucial step for students aiming to secure admission in engineering, agriculture, or medical courses in various colleges across Telangana. This process involves registration, certificate verification, choice filling, seat allotment, and reporting to the allotted college. To ensure a smooth and successful counselling experience, it's essential to keep the following important points in mind:

- **Keep Documents Ready:** Ensure all required documents (rank card, hall ticket, Aadhaar, SSC/Intermediate marks memo, caste certificate, income certificate, etc.) are ready and in the prescribed format.
- **Register on Time:** Stick to the official schedule for registration and web options. Missing deadlines can cost you a seat.
- **Pay Processing Fee:** Pay the counselling processing fee online as per your category before certificate verification.
- **Attend Certificate Verification:** Visit the designated help center on your scheduled date and time for document verification.

- **Check Eligibility Criteria:** Verify the eligibility criteria (qualifying marks, domicile, age, etc.) before applying for specific courses or colleges.
- **Prioritize College & Course Preferences:** Fill in your web options carefully in the order of preference. Use mock allotment results (if available) to plan better.
- **Monitor Seat Allotment:** Regularly check the official website for seat allotment results and further instructions.
- **Download Allotment Order:** After seat allotment, download and print the allotment order for reporting to the college.
- **Report to Allotted College:** Report within the given time frame with required documents and pay the tuition fee, if applicable.
- **Participate in Further Rounds:** If not satisfied with the seat, you may participate in further phases of counselling as per the instructions.
- **Stay Updated:** Follow the official TS EAMCET website and announcements to avoid missing any important updates or changes.

Mistakes to Avoid During TS EAMCET Counselling

- **Missing Deadlines:** Failing to register or attend document verification on time can disqualify you from the entire process.
- **Incorrect Document Submission:** Submitting wrong, invalid, or incomplete documents can lead to rejection during verification.
- **Choosing Unrealistic Options:** Filling only top colleges or courses without a backup can result in no seat allotment.
- **Ignoring Category/Locality Quotas:** Not using your applicable reservation (SC/ST/BC, Local/Non-local) may lower your chances unnecessarily.
- **Not Freezing the Allotted Seat:** If you don't freeze or report to the allotted college within the given time, your seat may be cancelled.

FAQs

Q1. Who will conduct the TG EAPCET Counselling Process?

Ans. Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TSCHE) will conduct the TS EAMCET counselling process 2025 online at the official website.

Q2. How many rounds of counselling will be conducted for TS EAMCET 2025?

Ans. TS EAMCET 2025 counselling will be conducted in 3 rounds. There will also be one special round for Internal Sliding and the Spot Admission.

Q3. What is the educational eligibility for TS EAMCET 2025 counselling?

Ans. Candidates need to have a minimum of 45% in the 10+2 level with PCM or PCB as the main subjects. However, the eligibility is 40% for the reserved category.

Q4. Will the authorities conduct the TS EAMCET 2025 spot round?

Ans. Yes, in case of any vacant seats even after 3 rounds of counselling, the authorities will likely conduct a spot round to fill out the vacant seats.

Q5. How do I apply for TG EAPCET or TS EAMCET counselling?

Ans. After you qualify for TG EAPCET, you can go to the official website and apply for registration by paying the counselling fee.

Q6. What are the documents required for TG EAPCET Counselling 2025?

Ans. For the TG EAPCET 2025 counselling process, applicants must prepare a set of essential documents. These include the TS EAPCET rank card and hall ticket, Aadhaar card, academic records from Class 6 through Intermediate, and the Transfer Certificate. If applicable, candidates should also provide caste, residence, and income certificates. Additionally, those belonging to special categories such as PH, CAP, NCC, Sports, or Minority must present the relevant supporting documents.

Q7. I got an 11k rank in TS EAMCET 2021. Can I get a seat in a good college for engineering?

Ans: With a rank of 11k in TS EAMCET 2025, you can get admission to Vardhaman College of Engineering, Rangaraju Institute of Engineering and Technology, Malla Reddy College of Engineering and Technology, Gokaraju, Sreenidhi Institute of Science and Technology, etc.

Q8. Can I participate in TS EAMCET first phase counselling if I failed one subject in the second year and am waiting for supplementary results?

Ans. The eligibility requirements for TS EAMCET counselling 2025 can differ based on the state and the specific year of the examination. Generally, candidates are expected to have completed their intermediate (12th grade) or an equivalent qualification.

If a student fails the intermediate examination, it could affect their ability to take part in the TS EAMCET 2025 counselling process. Typically, only those who meet the minimum academic qualifications set by the exam authorities are considered eligible for counselling.

Q9. Is there any sports quota available for TS EAMCET counselling for the allotment of seats in colleges?

Ans. Yes, sports quota is available in TS EAMCET. You need to have state or national-level certificates.

Q10. Which candidates can participate in the TS EAMCET round 2 choice filling?

Ans. The candidates who fall into the following situations can participate in the round 2 choice filling of TS EAMCET counselling:

- Candidates who have secured seats but are not interested in joining.
- Those who have not secured seats so far but have had their certificates verified.
- Those who have not exercised the options so far but have gotten their certificates verified.
- Those who have secured a seat, self-reported, and are aspiring for a better option.
- And any other eligible candidates.
