About WBJEE 2025

The West Bengal Joint Entrance Examination, conducted by the WBJEEB, is a state-level entrance examination in West Bengal. Candidates who qualify for the WBJEE exam are eligible for undergraduate courses like engineering, architecture, and pharmacy. Students have to appear for the counselling process upon qualifying for the WBJEE examination. Students are allotted admissions to the colleges based on merit, vacancies and category.

WBJEE Eligibility Criteria 2025

Check the WBJEE 2025 eligibility criteria:

Criteria	Details
Citizenship	Applicant must be an Indian citizen or OCI (subject to approval by the Competent Authority).
Qualification	Must have passed or be appearing in the 12th standard (10+2) or equivalent exam in 2025.
Age Limit (General)	Minimum age: 17 years as of 31.12.2025 (Born on or before 31.12.2008). No upper age limit.
Age Limit (Marine Engineering)	For the Marine Engineering Course, the upper age limit is 25 years as of 31.12.2025.
Academic Criteria	Candidates must follow the latest rules from relevant universities and regulatory bodies (AICTE, PCI). The Board will not be responsible for unaware candidates regarding updated information.

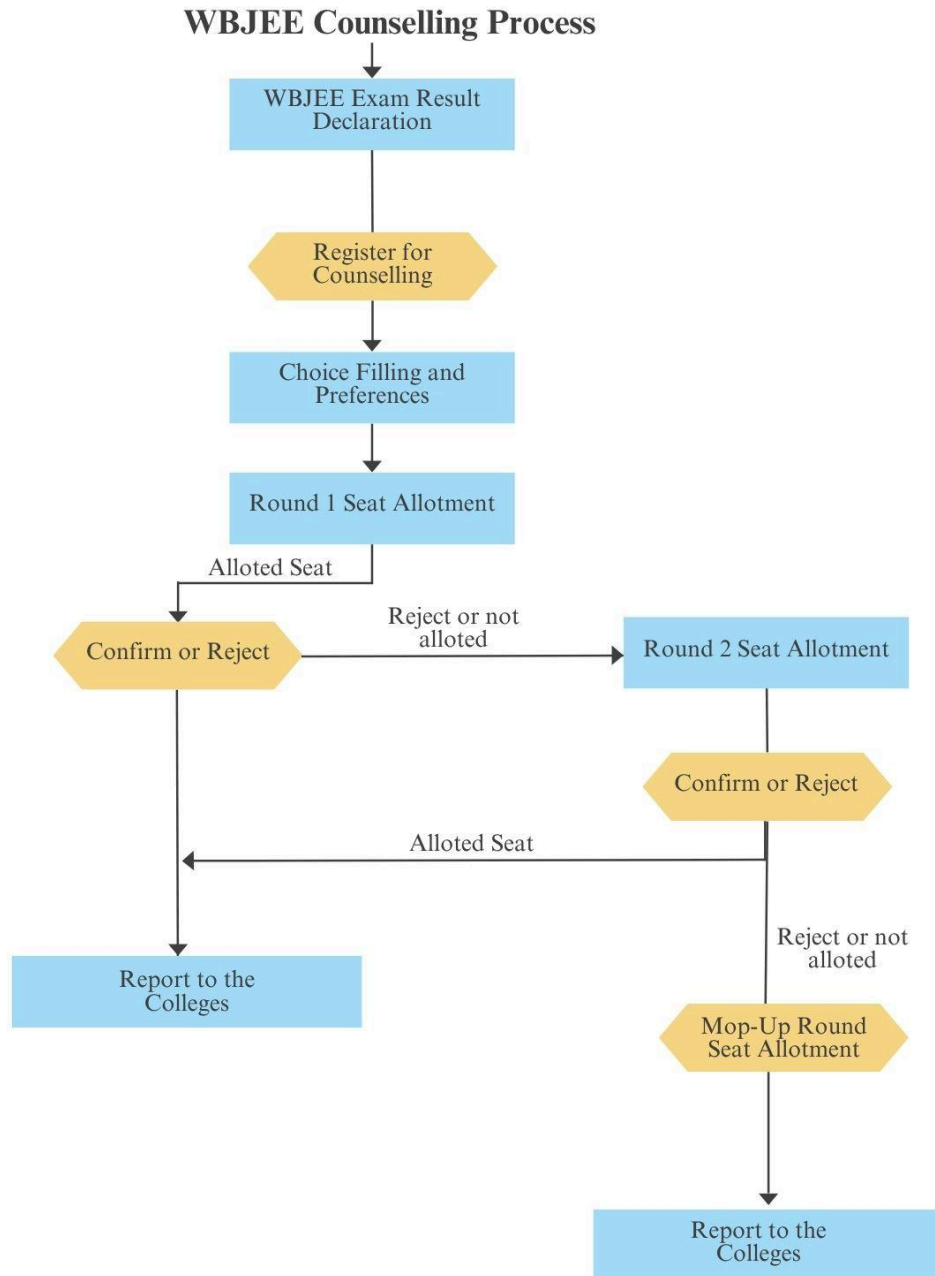
WBJEE 2025 Exam Pattern

The exam will consist of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs), with four options for each question. Each subject will have three categories of questions. The number of questions and the maximum marks for each category will vary across subjects. Detailed information regarding the number of questions and the corresponding marks for each category will be provided in the

official exam pattern table. Candidates should familiarise themselves with the distribution of questions and marks for proper preparation.

How to Apply for the WBJEE Counselling Process?



Step 1: WBJEE Exam Result Declaration

The WBJEE 2025 exam results will be declared in June 2025 on the official website (wbjeeb.nic.in). Candidates can check their scores and get an estimated rank.

Step 2: Registration for Counselling

Eligible candidates need to register online for WBJEE Counselling in July 2025. During registration, candidates will fill in their personal details, academic information, and upload required documents such as Class 10 & 12 marksheets and Hall Ticket. The non-refundable

registration fee of ₹500 must be paid through online payment methods (net banking, debit/credit card).

Step 4: Provisional Seat Allotment (Round 1)

The seat allotment list will be released by the officials, where candidates will find their allotted college and course. Candidates will be allotted seats based on their rank and preferences. After checking the allotment, candidates need to confirm or reject the seat offered.

Step 5: Round 2 Seat allotment

Candidates who were not allotted the seats in round 1 or are looking for upgradation are eligible to participate in round 2 counselling.

Step 5: Reporting to Allotted Colleges

Candidates who are allotted a seat must report to the respective college for document verification and admission confirmation. Required documents include a rank card, an admit card, a category certificate (if applicable), and other certificates for verification.

Step 6: Mop-Up Round (If Applicable)

If seats remain vacant after Round 1 and Round 2, a mop-up round will be conducted in August 2025. Candidates can re-register and fill in their choices for the mop-up round. After seat allotment, candidates must report to the colleges for final seat confirmation and admission.

- Email and Mobile Number:** Provide an active email address and mobile number. All essential updates regarding WBJEE will be communicated via these channels.
- Fee Payment:** Ensure you have the necessary payment methods (online or offline) to pay the counselling registration fee. The fee must be paid on time to avoid missing out on counselling.
- Strict Adherence to Deadlines:** Follow all WBJEE deadlines for registration, choice filling, and other procedures. Missing any deadline can result in the cancellation of candidature.
- Official Website:** Complete all registration and counselling steps only on the official WBJEE website (<https://wbjeeb.nic.in>). Avoid third-party or fraudulent sites.
- Seek Assistance:** If you face any issues or discrepancies during the WBJEE counselling process, reach out to the official helpdesk for clarification and support.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How to apply for the WBJEE Counselling process?

Students can apply for the WBJEE counselling process by visiting the online website, submitting the required documents and paying the WBJEE registration fees.

2. What are the WBJEE eligibility criteria?

Students must have passed or be appearing for the Class 12th examination from a recognised board in order to appear for the WBJEE exam.

3. What are the WBJEE counselling registration fees?

The WBJEE counselling registration fee is INR 500 (non-refundable), payable online. A seat acceptance fee of INR 5,000 is required for allotted candidates, while the Mop-Up Round involves a registration fee of INR 1,000 and a participation fee of INR 200. [1, 2, 3]

4. When will the WBJEE results be declared?

The WBJEE 2025 exam results are expected to be declared in June 2025 on the official website.

5. What documents are required for WBJEE counselling?

Candidates must present documents such as Class X and XII marksheets, WBJEE admit card, rank card, category certificate (if applicable), and other required certificates for document verification during the counselling process.

6. Which one is easier, JEE or WBJEE?

WBJEE is considered easier compared to JEE Mains. JEE Main exam requires a deeper understanding of the problems compared to WBJEE.

7. What are the top 5 colleges accepting WBJEE scores?

1. Jadavpur University (JU)
2. Calcutta University (CU)
3. Narula Institute of Technology
4. Techno International New Town

8. How was the WBJEE 2025 exam difficulty?

The WBJEE 2025 exam difficulty was considered moderate to easy compared to the previous years.

9. Is there any dress code to follow for WBJEE?

There are no official guidelines regarding the WBJEE Dress code; however, students are advised to appear for the exam with simple clothes and avoid clothes with heavy designs and multiple pockets.

10. 10. Can candidates from other states apply for WBJEE?

Yes, candidates from other states can apply; however, state quota reservations are only for West Bengal-domiciled candidates. Others are considered under the open (general) category.
